

Plasticolors Color Award Winner

Ashtabula, Ohio – December 22, 2004 – Every year, Plasticolors proudly sponsors the Color Innovation Award. The award is a unique glass sculpture which is presented at the American Composites Manufacturers Association (ACMA) to a company that promotes the composites industry by using color as a major component in creating marketplace acceptance.

The 2004 winner of the award is Continental Structural Plastics.

The award is based on the Sabrex water filter housing which is molded by Continental Structural Plastics and used as a component in an industrial water filtration system that is designed to operate outdoors fully exposed to the elements. The Sabrex water filtration system is designed to purify industrial waste water to allow for safe discharge into the environment.

The SMC used is a UV stable, black molded-in-color material manufactured by Molded Products Division – Interplastic Corporation. It features Ekadure 2001 polyester resin and Aropol 5920 B-side resin sold by Ashland Specialty Chemical Corporation with the B-side being toll manufactured by Plasticolors, Inc.
